

# In2MedSchool

In2MedSchool is a widening participation initiative that consists of a group of medical students and junior doctors helping underprivileged school children apply to study Medicine and related subjects at University.

# Mentorship Team

This team is responsible for overseeing the running of our free, national 1:1 mentoring scheme where aspiring medics are matched with a local medical student/doctor who will be there mentor throughout the application process.

### Role Description & Requirements

- Coordinate, train and be the primary contact for Regional Heads they were assigned at the beginning of the year, including managing day-to-day activities and setting targets.
- Serve as a point of call for coordination and expansion of their regions.
- Liaise with Regional Heads and third-party stakeholders to increase awareness of the charity.
- Review monthly progress reports from Regional Heads and arrange regular virtual meetings (at a schedule defined yearly before the start of the academic year)



- Organise and conduct appropriate welfare checks and meetings with those Regional Heads under their supervision.
- On a rota basis, open and maintain Zoom breakout rooms.
- Meet regularly with the appropriate Mentorship Director to provide an update on the region's progress.
- Escalate concerns about Regional Heads promptly to the appropriate Mentorship Director.
- Escalate concerns relating to Mentor, Mentee or Regional Head's wellbeing, welfare or safeguarding promptly to the Director of Welfare.
- Otherwise assist the Mentorship Team with general administrative responsibilities, as needed and agreed by all parties.

### Essential Criteria

- Must have been a Regional Head or held a subcommittee position at In2MedSchool.
- Completed A-level education in the country, or has sound knowledge of its education system.
- Currently studies at a university located in the country.
- Desire to contribute to the expansion of widening participation in Medicine nationally.
- Willingness to approach schools, charities or individuals across the country to establish collaborations.



#### Desirable Criłeria

- Has established contacts with schools, charities or individuals in the country.
- Knowledge/awareness of local criminal disclosure procedures.

## Time Commitment

- Approximately 4-6 hours/week (variable, depending on time of year).
- Meeting with the respective director monthly.
- Administrative responsibility of running zoom breakout rooms for 2h on one weekend day every 5-6 weeks (on a rota basis).
